OHIO CANAL & TRAIN EXCURSION

Come ride the Toledo, Lake Erie & Western Ry and the scenic Miami & Erie Canal located in Northern Ohio. The Blue Bird train rides the historic rails of the Nickel Plate's Cloverleaf Division in Waterville, Ohio. It's a pleasant journey in vintage passenger cars that starts at the old Nickel Plate Road's station and runs through the Ohio country side.

The Toledo Area Metroparks maintains a portion of the early 1800's Miami an Erie Canal that connected Lake Erie to the Ohio River in Cincinnati, Ohio. The *Volunteer*, a mule drawn barge, will take us along this historic canal accompanied by park staff dressed in period costume and narrating the tour.

While we are visiting the area we will tour the water powered Isaac Ludwig operating saw and grist mill, plus a fully stocked General Store filled with gifts and collectibles and other shops.



The trip will depart by deluxe motor coach from Henry Ford Centennial Library northwest corner, on Michigan Ave, Dearborn, MI. at 9:00 AM. Map will be provided when you place your order. There will be a short stop before our 11:30 AM arrival at the canal.

After the canal ride we will proceed to our Lunch stop returning after the train ride to visit the mill and shops.

Our train ride in Waterville is scheduled for 4:00 PM . We expect to return to Dearborn approximately 7:00 PM.
